

Livermon Park & Mini-zoo is owned and operated by the Town of Windsor. It is enjoyed all year long by young and old. The park was dedicated on July 7, 1991 in honor of the former Mayor of Windsor, L.T. Livermon.

It offers a wide variety of recreational enjoyment, from visiting with the animals, taking the Wetlands Walk, picnicking, playing on the many pieces of playground equipment to free canoeing through the wetlands. Children especially love exploring the old fire truck on display in the park.

There are restroom facilities on site as well as picnic pavilions and picnic tables. There is a gift shop located inside the Windsor/Bertie County Chamber of Commerce office, which is in the Old Freeman Hotel (circa 1840) located on the park grounds.

Many schools and daycare facilities journey to Livermon Park & Mini-zoo for class trips each year. Also, church and other civic organizations often use the grounds for parties and other outings. Of course, families visit daily for day trips.
